

## CLTC Singles Box League Rules

1. Scoring - 2 short sets to 4 games with a tiebreak to 7 at 3-3 and at 1 set all a match tiebreak to 10 points. Each game will feature sudden death deuce on the second deuce and the receiver decides which side the point begins on.
2. Players will receive points as follows:

Win 2-0: 4 points

Win 2-1: 3 points

Lose 1-2 2 points

Lose 0-2: 1 point

Unplayed: 0 points

Walkover: 3 points to winner and -1 point to opponent

Points will be accumulated over the 4 matches/6 weeks.

3. 5 singles players in each box depending on entries.
4. The league will be updated 6 weeks from when the boxes are issued to all players via email. You have 6 weeks to play the required 4 games.
5. All match results will be sent via e-mail to Venu
6. Top finisher will be promoted 1 box up and the bottom finisher relegated 1 box down, and the 3 players who finished in the middle of their box will remain in the same box.
7. The promotion or relegation of a player will be according to the complete match results with no handicapping. If there is a tie in scores, the head-to-head results will determine placing.
8. The league coordinator reserves the right to move a player up or down as many boxes as may be necessary to ensure fair competition.
9. Please make the best effort to arrive on-time for your matches. If a player arrives more than 15min late the first set is forfeited.
10. In the event of a "no show", the score will be 3 and -1 as if it were a walkover.
11. Players should apply the normal rules of tennis and 'self-umpire'.
12. Balls – Are self-provided and a good standard of balls is expected
13. Any new players wishing to join will start at the appropriate box as per the league co-ordinators decision. This may be the lowest box of the league.
14. It is open to all adult members and to juniors who have been nominated by the coaches to play in Social
